

Cookies

Swiss International AB uses the technology known as “cookies” to collect information on how you use the website, and to ensure your visit runs smoothly. Cookies are text files that are stored in the Internet browser or come from the Internet browser on the user’s computer system. When a user visits a website, a cookie may be stored on the user’s computer.

We use analysis cookies for the purpose of improving the quality of our website and its contents. Analysis cookies allow us to ascertain how the website is used and thus constantly optimise our service.

Google Analytics

The Swiss International AB website utilises Google Analytics, a web analytics tool by Google Inc. (“Google”). Google Analytics uses “cookies”, text files stored on your computer that enable analysis of how you use the website. The cookie-generated information about your use of this website is usually transmitted to and stored on a Google server in the United States. However, Google will first truncate your IP address. Only by way of exception will the full IP address be transmitted to a Google server in the United States and shortened there. Google will use such information to evaluate your use of the website, to compile reports on website activity and to provide other services to Swiss International AB in relation to website use and internet use.

Deleting cookies

If you do not want your browser to accept cookies, you can deactivate or restrict this option in your browser settings. Cookies that have already been saved can be deleted at any time.

Your rights

As a data subject, you have a number of rights. You can:

- object to the processing of your data where Swiss International AB is relying on its legitimate interests as the legal ground for processing.
